The first, written stage after which the briefs of the Teams are submitted to an expert panel of Civil Rights Defenders for evaluation and grading. The second, oral pleading stage, takes place at the competition. The competition is based on the experiences and the model of the Nordic Moot Court, which has been regularly organized in the member states of the Nordic Union, since 1984.
