

Robert Blažević

Robert Blazevic was born on 2th November 1955 in Otocac where he attended grammar school. He graduated from the Faculty of Law at the University of Rijeka in February 1979, and from the Faculty of Political Science (Department of Politology) in June 1982. He completed his Master's degree (postgraduate study in administrative and political sciences) in January 1985 at the Faculty of Law of the University of Zagreb. He received his PhD in December 1991 at the Faculty of Political Sciences of the University of Zagreb, with the thesis titled "Theories of Legitimacy of Political Systems".

From 1st March 1982 until 1991 he worked as assistant lecturer at the Faculty of Law of the University of Rijeka (the course unit titled "Public Administration"). He was appointed assistant professor in 1993, associate professor in 2005, and full professor in January 2012. In April 2017. he was appointed tenured professor.

In the period 1988 until 1991 he was president of the Faculty Council. During the academic year 1994/1995 he held the position of vice-dean in charge of scientific and research work. Since 2011 he has been a member of the editorial board of the journal "Croatian and Comparative Public Administration".

He participated in several scientific projects and in numerous scientific congresses. Currently he teaches the courses "Public Administration" and „Administration Sociology" at the Faculty of Law. At the Administration Department of the same Faculty he teaches three curses, and at the Specialist Graduate Professional Study of Public Administration he teaches another two courses. He has published 12 books and over sixty scientific papers.
