Andrzej Jakubowski works at the Institute of Law Studies of the Polish Academy of Sciences (Warsaw). He is a member of the ILA Committee on Cultural Heritage Law. Since 2014, he serves as a mediator at the UNESCO ICPRCP. He authored a monograph *State Succession in Cultural Property* (Oxford University Press, 2015), edited *Cultural Rights as Collective Rights – An International Law Perspective* (Brill-Nijhoff 2016), and co-edited the volumes: *Fragmentation vs. the Constitutionalisation of International Law – A Practical Inquiry* (Routledge, 2016), *Pravo wobec erotyki w sztuce oraz pornografii* (Silva Rerum, 2016). He is a member of the editorial board of the Polish Yearbook of International Law and a theme editor of *Santander Art & Culture Law Review*.
