Karlyn Stanley is a lawyer focused on technology, including building and leading technology-focused legal practices for two international companies and a national law firm, handling high-profile regulatory litigation as a senior lawyer at AT&T, and prosecuting white-collar crime as a Trial Attorney at the U.S. Department of Justice. She is currently leading a RAND project on AI Governance issues that will provide concise briefs on key issues to Congressional staff members on Capitol Hill. She is the lead author of a 2020 RAND study of the impact of autonomous vehicles on automobile insurance. She recently completed a RAND comparative study of legal regimes for AVs.
