



Call for Applications: TELSP

Toruń Economic and Legal Summer Program

Fellowship period: 17 August 2026 - 13 September 2026

Application deadline: 18 March 2026, 14.00 CET

The [Faculty of Economic Sciences and Management](#) and the [Faculty of Law and Administration at Nicolaus Copernicus University](#) (NCU) in Toruń, Poland, invite applications for the 6th edition of the Toruń Economic and Legal Summer Program (TELSP).

TELSP offers a four-week research fellowship during which participants develop an individual research project under the supervision of NCU faculty members. The program provides an interdisciplinary academic environment combining law and economics, along with opportunities to build international academic and professional networks.

Applicants may choose from a range of research areas of law and economics (for the whole list see [here](#)), including **human rights**-related topics:

- Contemporary problems of human rights protection (supervisor: dr Julia Kapelańska-Pręgowska)
- Inclusive and pluralistic societies. A human rights approach (supervisor: dr Julia Kapelańska-Pręgowska)
- Human rights law – an idea or a practical concept? (supervisor: dr Piotr Sadowski)

Eligibility: Applications are open to undergraduate and graduate students enrolled at foreign universities who demonstrate strong academic engagement and motivation to pursue an individual research project. Candidates from developing countries are particularly encouraged to apply.

Funding and Program Details: Fellowships are funded by NCU and include accommodation in a student dormitory (single rooms), a daily allowance (90 PLN), and participation in the academic and social programs. Please note that travel expenses and visa fees are not covered.
